Make sure you are responsible for the quality of the premises at all times.

Violence or abuse to any member or staff will not be tolerated and may result in a ban from the club.

Bar management are not to be challenged on decisions to refuse alcohol to any individual.

No members other than on-duty bar staff or named officials of the club will be allowed behind the bar at any time.

Any damage caused by a member will be the sole responsibility of that member to rectify regardless of the cost.

Any damage caused by a member to the club facilities may result in a ban from the club.

All members and players will abide by our drug and alcohol policy.
