Everyone involved in the Boroughmuir Rugby whether a player, volunteer, coach, official, Club member or spectator is expected to uphold Scottish Rugby's core values:

Leadership : Engagement : Achievement : Enjoyment : Respect

Boroughmuir Rugby is committed to providing a safe, welcoming and friendly environment for all players, coaches, officials and visitors. To this end, the following Code of Conduct is in place for spectators, members, parents and carers:

Remember that children and young people play for enjoyment as well as competition.

Stay outside the field of play and in the Spectator's Area (where provided).

Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.

Always respect the match officials' decisions.

Applaud effort and good play as well as success.

Let the coaches do their job and do not confuse the players by telling them what to do.

Encourage the players to respect the opposition and match officials.

Never criticise a player for making a mistake. Remember that mistakes are an important part of learning and wellbeing

Pass on any concerns that you have about the wellbeing of a child or young person to a club official

If you are a parent, please remember that your behaviour may affect not only your child but the other children and young people participating.

Shall not publish criticism of fellow players, members or match officials on social media
